At AMAG Technology, we are committed to responsible sourcing and strive to work with suppliers who uphold strong standards of human rights, integrity, and environmental responsibility. In accordance with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act and the OECD Due Diligence Guidance, we take all reasonable steps to reduce the risk of conflict minerals—gold, tin, tantalum, and tungsten—being used in our supply chain, as such materials may finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and surrounding regions.

While complete certainty in global supply chains is challenging, we implement a robust due diligence process, requiring relevant suppliers to provide documented evidence (in the form of a completed CMRT report) of their sourcing practices. We continuously review compliance efforts and work closely with our partners to enhance supply chain transparency. Through these measures, we aim to uphold responsible sourcing practices to the greatest extent possible.
